At the beginning of the Autumn Term, Year 5 pupils Take **PT English and Maths assessments** (externally validated by GL assessment) in order for the school to determine standards of attainment on entry. These are always **significantly below the national average** in Maths and **in line with the national average** in English.

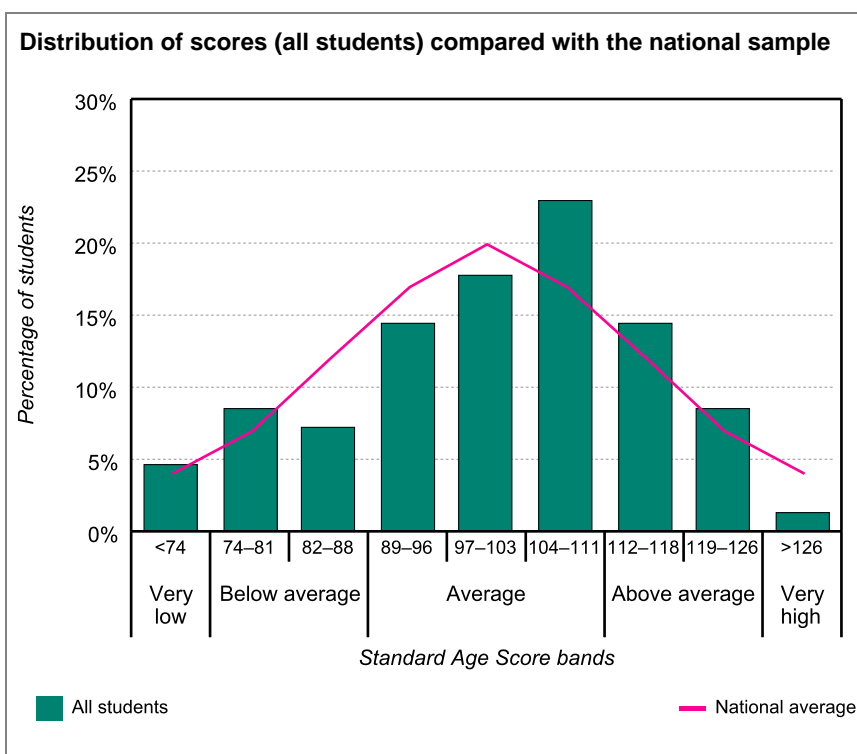

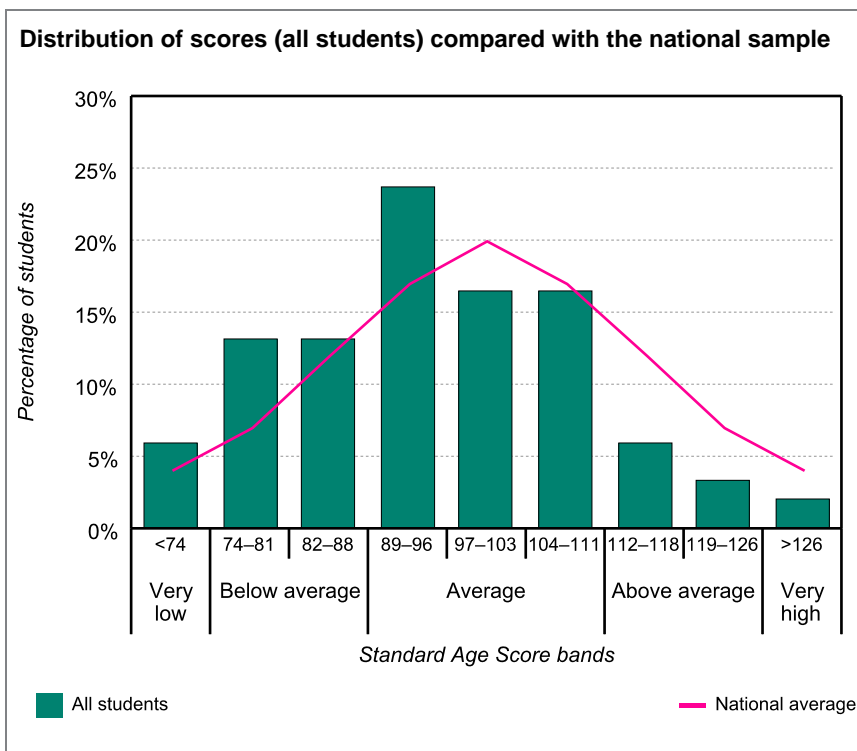
