### 2016/17 Year 8 Exit Attainment

In the Summer Term, Year 8 pupils take PT English and Maths assessments (externally validated by GL assessment) in order for the school to determine their final outcomes. The data below shows how the school's pupils are **clearly exceeding national averages**.

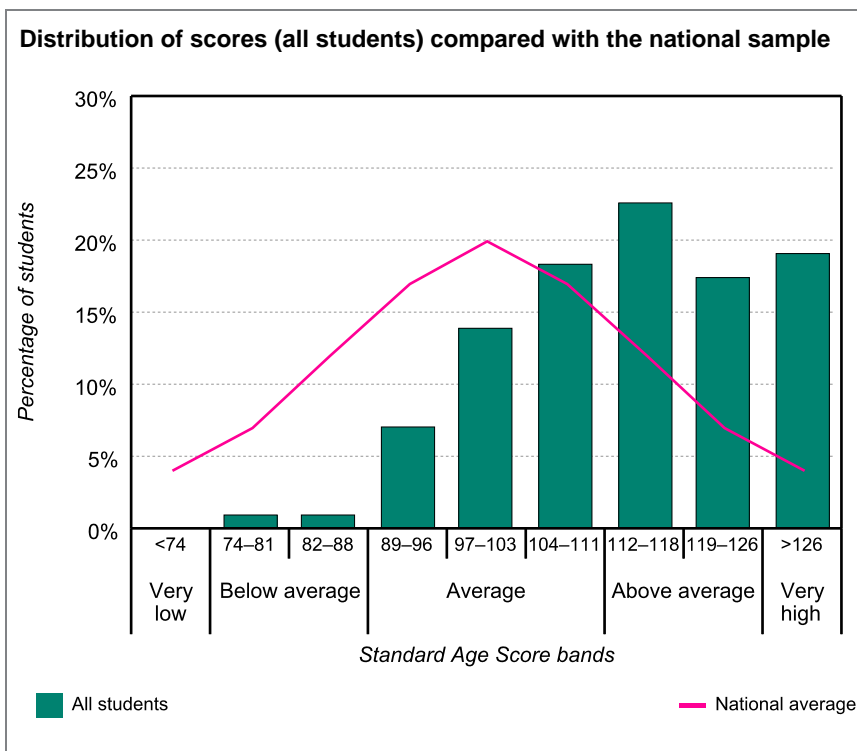

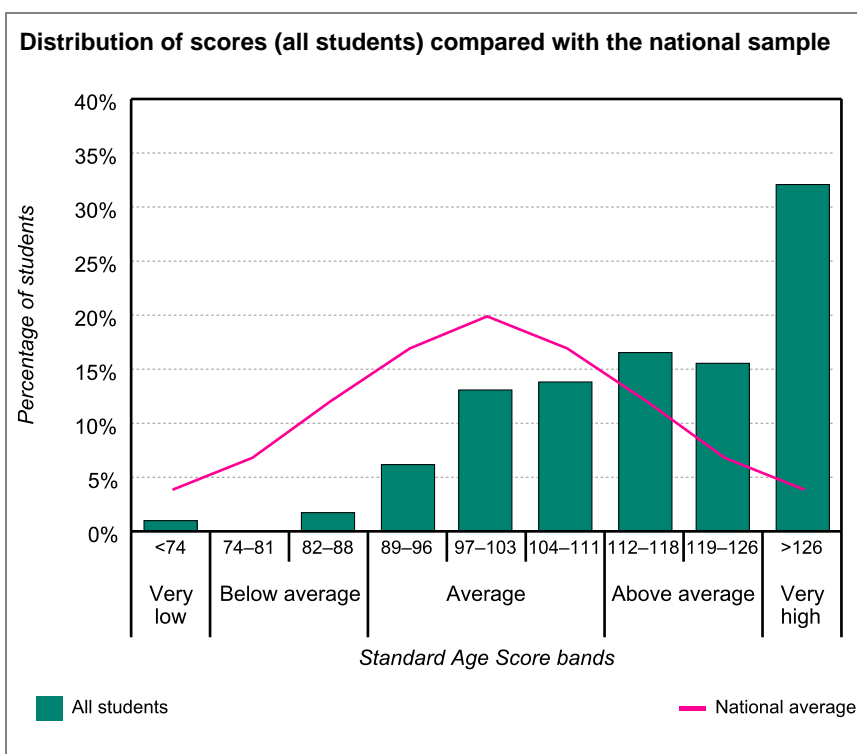
